QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

The ASSE Admissions Committee develops criteria for assigning membership classifications based on the applicant's certification, registration, education, experience and job responsibilities, as follows:

Professional Member-requires

1. P.E. registration, CSP, CIH, CHP, CRSP, or IOSH, RSP certification PLUS 5 years safety experience, or
2. Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university PLUS 10 years safety experience.

Member-requires current employment in safety or one of its relevant specialities.

Associate Member-for those who provide services to the safety profession or who cooperate with safety professionals.

Professional Members and Members

must also be employed in the Safety Profession or one of its specialities, performing at least two of the following functions of the professional safety position:

1. Anticipate, identify and evaluate hazardous conditions and practices.

2. Develop hazard control designs, methods, procedures and programs.
3. Implement, administer and advise others on hazard controls and hazard control programs.
4. Measure, audit and evaluate the effectiveness of hazard controls and hazard control programs.

Student applicants should request a separate application for Student Membership.
